The Roping Division features the best female ropers in the WPRA competing in team roping (header and heeler), tie-down roping and breakaway roping. World titles are awarded in each division as well as in the all-around category in which a competitor competes in more than one event winning more money than the rest of the field.

Sporting a small but loyal membership (that is currently growing in numbers and events), the women of the Roping Division have the opportunity to compete at events all over the United States in search of a world title.

Standings, based on money won at the

approved and co-approved events, are kept just like they are in the barrel racing division. At the end of the year, the WPRA hosts a World Finals featuring top competitors from each of the roping events that gives each competitor one last chance to win enough money to capture a world title.

This section features the 2009 World Champions as well as listings of past champions not only in the roping events but in the roughstock events of bareback riding and bull riding, when that was offered through the WPRA.

Hobbs repeats as WPRA All-Around and Tie-Down Roping World Champion

It took Jackie Hobbs about a month to reflect on her run at the WPRA World Finals and her all-around and tie-down roping world championships.

But she had an awful lot going on through the end of November and first of December. It just comes with the territory of being an excellent roper and fantastic horsewoman. And when she put her mind to her accomplishments, she reflected upon an awfully strong season.

“When you put both the titles together, it shows you spend a lot of time on it all to make it all fit,” said Hobbs of Abilene, Texas, who

won both titles a year ago, too. “It shows you can handle your rope in every event.”

During the finals in Tulsa, Hobbs handled things plenty well, competing in all four roping disciplines and pulling money from each event. In fact, she earned more than \$8,000 over her weeklong stay in northeast Oklahoma, just down the road from where she competed in high school rodeo.

Her biggest take came in tie-down roping, where she won two go-rounds and placed in the other two, winning the average and \$3,529. She also won rounds in heading and heeling, finish-

ing second in the heading average.

“Winning back to back titles is part of who you are, because when you compete, you strive to win and work harder and harder to make it happen,” Hobbs said. “It’s nice to say that it wasn’t just once. Doing it twice just backed it up.”

Hobbs credited a lot of things en route to her world titles. Her team, consisting of great horses and outstanding roping hands, were big reasons behind her titles. By working with champs like Tibba Smith, Se’vette Early and Lari Dee Guy, Hobbs has surrounded herself with winners.

“All of us that team up are all very serious about what we do,” Hobbs said. “We all have confidence in ourselves and in each other. We don’t get to practice together as much, but we’ve roped together so much that we know what we’re going to get.

“You don’t have to worry about your partner, because you know they’re going to practice as hard, if not harder, than you.”

Hobbs works with Guy when they’re not rodeoing. They put on clinics, teaching roping and horsemanship skills to those aching to learn. In fact, they put on a clinic in Australia shortly after the finals, allowing intercontinental flights to help her memory recall.

“We do these clinics all year round,” Hobbs said. “We went to Australia to do three roping clinics. It was a blast, and they want us back.

“We try to do at least 10 schools a year. We’ve been to Hawaii, Sweden and now Australia. It’s an important aspect of our busi-

ness.”

There were three targets in Se’Vette Early’s sites for the 2009 season.

Now there are three memorable bullseyes and a Texas-sized grin for the girl from Flat who directly hit on each of her goals this season. First and foremost, Early won the WPRA’s heading world championship, culminating a strong year with a solid finish at the World Finals in mid-November in Tulsa, Okla.

She also won the rookie-of-the-year

ness.”

So is roping for competition. Once back in the States, Hobbs was back on the road, competing at the World Series Team Roping at the South Point Hotel & Casino in Las Vegas. The event took place in conjunction with the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo, and it was a showcase of some fantastic ropers.

“It’s a big event, with each roping paying out over \$1 million,” she said. “My partner and I walked away with \$23,000.”

It comes down to not only roping well but also roping with confidence. Four world titles in two years helps with the latter, but so does having quality horses. Back in November in Tulsa, Hobbs was confident in the mounts she used in the various roping categories.

“Those horses have to stay on top of things through all four rounds, and they were all solid,” she said. “They all worked great. I felt like I was riding the best horses there. There was no mistake made by my horses, for sure.”

Besides her big payday in tie-down roping, Hobbs left with various checks from the other three roping disciplines: \$1,256 from breakaway, \$1,273 from heeling and \$2,004 in heading.

“You have to have fun, because if you don’t, you’re not going to enjoy it much,” Hobbs said. “It’s always been a blast, just to rodeo and to rope. You get to hang around the people you like.

“But at the same time, this is what I do for a living, and I have to be serious about what I’m doing.”

she credited her heeler, Smith, for allowing her to sit atop the world.

"Tibba Smith is the hero," Early said. "She's the one to stop the clock every time."

And while her partnerships have catapulted her to the championship, there's something to be said for Early's roping. Cowgirls don't reach the pinnacle of the sport without having their own fair share of talent. And when championships are fought for – and won – with less than \$10,000 in the bank, there's something to be said about having that want-to.

"I rope because I love it," she said. "I love to ride horses. I love to try to figure out the science of it – what makes you catch; what makes you miss. I would do it all day long if I could."

Maybe it is in her genes. Her father was a roper who won the Cheyenne (Wyo.) Frontier Days more than half a century ago. Se'Vette Early always roped, then started team roping in the early 1990s. Her rookie crown isn't so much a matter of her youth, but more her transitioning into WPRA events and putting her talents on display for the world to see.

"Lari Dee kind of discovered me probably about 2004," Early said. "We just hit it off and have been friends ever since."

And it's worked pretty well. With Smith, Guy and Hobbs in her back pen, Early knows she has the support she needs to chase her dreams. Not only do her partners rope well, but they all offer her tidbits of information to help her take the next step, improve and, most

importantly, win championships.

"The pieces came together at the finals," she said. "This is probably one of the most consistent roping years I've had. I roped my best, and I was really consistent. I was catching in the same spot, giving the same type of run for my partners. My horse was really outstanding. We clicked this year, and he just made a huge difference in my success."

Her horse is Richard, a 21-year-old gray gelding, but he wasn't the only man in her life to make a difference. She also leaned on her husband, Sam, and their 5-year-old son, Slone, both of whom were pillars of strength every time she backed into the box in Tulsa.

"Sam loves to rope, too, but we're in between horses right now," she said. "Sam is a No. 6 in the U.S. ropings, and he's got to have a really good horse to compete at his level. He hasn't got to go much, but he's been a wonderful supporter, and he takes care of Slone."

"Sam still helps me with the barrier and the steers I draw. He's probably my No. 1 fan and my No. 1 supporter."

She needed all she could to maintain her lead over Brandi Mueller of Guymon, Okla., who finished as the reserve world champ. Mueller, who roped with heeling champ Kasey Etbauer, finished the season with \$4,187.

And if winning a world title gives one a feeling of being on top of the world, Se'Vette Early is right there. She's got a grin you can hear, and she's excited about all the possibilities that come with it.

"The truth of it is I really couldn't have made it this far without Classic Ropes, who have really helped me out a lot," she said. "But this is something I love. I'm a very competitive person, and I like to win. I like the feeling of being a winner."

"But I also like overcoming the obstacles, because you don't overcome them all. If this world championship has taught me anything,

it's that if you have faith, it will all turn around."

There's a lot to that. Besides her Christian faith, she also has to have faith in herself. But with her support team, she finds faith easily.

"When you compete, it's all mental – keeping focus and believing in myself," Early said.

Spoken like a true champion ... a world champion. 2009 World Champion Team Roper (Heeler)

When Kasey Etbauer backs into the heeling box, she has a lifetime of experiences and an overwhelming support system riding with her.

She realizes that plans change. She knows drawing a good steer doesn't mean the animal won't veer off or sprint to the other end of the arena. She knows what it takes to handle each situation as it arises.

Take the 2009 season, when early plans for her were to push her barrel horse to another qualification to the Dodge Prairie Circuit Finals Rodeo. Then came a summertime coup, of sorts, when she snagged a big paycheck during the co-sanctioned Windy Ryon Roping in Saginaw, Texas.

"Half my winnings came from Saginaw, and the other came from all the other ropings," said Etbauer of Goodwell, Okla., who finished 2009 with \$12,662, about \$4,200 ahead of second-place finisher Lari Dee Guy of Abilene, Texas.

The Windy Ryon win became a season-changing experience. Instead of running barrels at rodeos all across Oklahoma, Kansas and Nebraska, Etbauer spent more time in the heelers box. And even though her paycheck from the WPRA World Finals wasn't as big as she would've liked, she knows there was something magical this past season.

"Winning the world title wasn't something I was expecting as far as a goal for this year," she said. "It feels amazing to accomplish that. When you're roping with Lari Dee Guy and Jackie Hobbs and Tibba Smith, you have to be

on top of your game. They're tough competition."

So is Etbauer. Like Smith, Hobbs and Guy, she has roped all her life. She's also had the opportunity to be well-mounted. Most of the season, she's ridden Glady, a spectacular chocolate palomino mare. Like the bronc-busting Etbauer brothers – including Kasey's husband, Dan – Glady came off the family's South Dakota ranch.

And she's a special animal. Dan is a pickup man in the PRCA and uses Glady at a lot of rodeos, including the 2008 Wrangler National Finals Rodeo. When Glady isn't available to Kasey, she uses Harley, Dan's heel horse.

"We make sure I'm on good heel horses," she said. "It's kind of a juggling act, because I rope off Dan's pickup horses. In the summertime, it becomes quite interesting just trading out horses."

And while it was hectic, all that didn't matter when she got to the arena. Once there, she knew what it took to take care of business. She knew she'd be well-mounted, and all those years with a rope in her hands would most definitely pay off.

"The key for me is that I learned correctly, with my dad and my grandfather teaching me when I was younger," she said. "I've been able to rope with good ropers and improve myself. And, of course, I feel like I'm mounted on good horses."

There's something about family, in the past, in the present and in the future. While Robert, Billy and Dan Etbauer have made names for

themselves as saddle bronc riders, they're all ranch hands. Marrying into a clan willing to do whatever it takes to make things work helps in a lot of areas.

"The whole family is multitasking, period," Kasey Etbauer said. "I think it helps me because Dan had to make everything, whether it's in the bronc riding or a roping horse or whatever. It helps in honing my horsemanship, plus I've learned a lot on the mental aspect of it from him because he's been there, done that."

There is something special about the 2009 that Etbauer will always cherish. World titles

don't come every day. So will she defend her title in 2010?

"Oh, I'll still be roping," she said. "But I'll cut back on my roping because my barrel racing was sacrificed. My goal for next year is that I'll go to the big, good-paying ropings and hopefully make it back to the WPRA World Finals. But I don't know about running at a world title again.

"It's not something that I feel like I need to go back and do again. I'm excited about what I got, and I'm content."
