# 2009 Justin Best Footing Awards



The Justin Boot Company, in conjunction with the Women's Professional Rodeo Association, is proud to be the official sponsor of the "Justin Best Footing Program". Created in 1995, the "Justin Best Footing Program (JBF)" recognizes those rodeo committees who put forth an extra effort to ensure that their rodeo has the safest, most consistent, best ground conditions possible.

The JBF Program is an incentive program that targets the person most responsible for a rodeo's ground conditions - the tractor driver. The JBF Program acknowledges the best ground in each of the 12 WPRA Circuits. Committee awards include cash bonuses (ranging from \$350 - \$1,000), plaques and at certain award levels a pair of Justin Ostrich or Lizard boots. Then the 12 first place winners from the WPRA Circuits went into a hat to draw out an overall winner. The overall winner received a \$1,500 bonus check and a pair of Justin full-quill ostrich boots.

Each PRCA rodeo that has a WPRA sanctioned barrel race is eligible for a JBF award. The members of the WPRA vote on the rodeos in their respective circuits and the rodeos that receive the most votes, wins. There are no special forms to fill out.
