Due to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe has set the following travel guidelines for PRCA contestants who may need to travel through the Cheyenne River Reservation:

- Contestants MUST STOP at the checkpoint of entrance and answer the CRST COVID-19 Travel Plan/Health Questionnaire truthfully and honestly upon entry and exit
- Contestants MUST present their PRCA card(s) to the CRST Health and Safety Checkpoint staff
- Contestants MUST drive straight through the Cheyenne River Reservation without any stops

The Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe encourages contestants to stop outside of the Reservation boundaries for fuel/gas, food, etc. prior to entrance.


Spectators attending any rodeo or events associated with the rodeo are asked to seek an alternative route around the Reservation.
