

Fort Worth, TX –May 29-31, 2020.

Finishing Super Series.

All contestants who were originally placed in the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Super Series at Houston must verify their intent to compete by calling PROCOM between 10 AM (Mountain Time) on Wednesday, May 20 and 10 AM (Mountain Time) on Thursday, May 21. There will be no replacements for contestants who turn out or who do not confirm their intent to compete.

The contestants who competed in the first and the second performances of the third Super Series at Houston, which occurred on March 9 and 10, will have the opportunity to compete for the third performance of that Super Series, which was originally scheduled for March 11. This performance will occur on May 29 in Fort Worth, TX at 7:00 PM. The contestants who were originally scheduled to compete in the fourth Houston Super Series, originally scheduled for March 12, 13, and 14 will have the opportunity to compete for all three performances of the fourth Super Series on May 30 at 10:00 AM, 2:00 PM, and 7:00 PM in Fort Worth. The contestants who were originally scheduled to compete in the fifth Houston Super Series, originally scheduled for March 16, 17, and 18 will have the opportunity to compete for all three performances of the fifth Super Series on Sunday, May 31 at 10:00 AM, 2:00 PM, and 7:00 PM in Fort Worth. There will be no Semi Finals, Wild Card Round, or Championship.

Trade Deadline: Tuesday, May 26 at 12 PM. All confirmed trades will be final and processed immediately after both involved parties have confirmed through PROCOM. Contestants originally placed in the third Super Series will not be allowed to trade since they have already competed.

Contestants who compete will each be paid a \$300 appearance fee. Each performance will pay: \$800 for first place, \$600 for second place, and \$400 for third place, and \$200 for fourth place. There will be no average payoff. Money paid out will not count towards PRCA/WPRA World Standings. Contestants will be awarded championship points (which will count towards PRCA/WPRA World Standings) equal to the championship points that were awarded for placing in the first Super Series on March 3-5, the second Super Series on March 6-8, and the first two performances of the third Super Series on March 9-10. Each performance will award 3000 points for first place, 2000 points for second place, 1000 points for third place, and 750 points for fourth place. There will be no average payoff. Money won will not count towards Texas Circuit Standings.
