GROUND RULES: Please provide any ground rules below. All ground rules must be clearly defined

Contestant Information:

1. Arena will be closed 2 hours prior to the performance and 1 hour prior to the slack to allow for ground prep and production requirements.
2. Doors will open 1 hour prior to performance for spectators.
3. All preconditioning of timed event cattle will be completed 1 hour prior to the start of slack or performance.
4. Hospitality area for competitors and 1 companion (pending COVID regulations)
5. Gate admission will be gained by producing CPRA card verified with contestant list for the day entered.
