- 1.1 The 2017 RODEOHOUSTON Super Series is an invitational championship rodeo featuring the top cowboy and cowgirl contestants in the sport of rodeo. HLSR management and staff have the sole authority and responsibility to determine the list of invitees to participate in each Super Series and to determine, on a case-by-case basis, which alternate entry will replace any originally invited contestant that chooses not to enter or decides, for whatever reason, not to compete. The initial invited list is determined using the following criteria (see 1.2). HLSR will not be subject to entry rules and procedures of any sanctioning organizations to include, but not limited to, grace periods and office rules. Further, HLSR retains the sole authority to accept or decline the entry of any and all contestants regardless of their standings on the invitation list below.
- 1.2 **Entry Procedures:** Bareback Riding, Barrel Racing, Bull Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding, Steer Wrestling, Team Roping Headers, Team Roping Heelers and Tie-Down Roping will consist of 40 contestants each (see 1.2 below).
- (a) Bareback Riding, Saddle Bronc Riding, Steer Wrestling and Tie-Down Roping invitation criteria:
 - i. Past four (4) RODEOHOUSTON Super Series Champions (2013 – 2016).
**Past RODEOHOUSTON Super Series Champions must be actively competing professionally, in the event they won, to be invited to compete. If not actively competing, they may be invited at the discretion of HLSR Management.*
 - ii. Three Special Invitations from HLSR Management.
 - iii. Reigning Canadian Professional Rodeo Association Champion.
 - iv. 2017 San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Champion.
 - v. 2016 All American ProRodeo Finals Champion.
 - vi. Top two of the published 2017 official PRCA world standings (as of Dec. 1, 2016).
 - vii. Top five of the published 2016 official ERA world standings.
 - ix. Remaining invitations will come from the published 2016 official PRCA world standings.
 - (b) Bull Riding invitation criteria:
 - i. Past four (4) RODEOHOUSTON Super Series Champions (2013 – 2016).
**Past RODEOHOUSTON Super Series Champions must be actively competing professionally, in the event they won, to be invited to compete. If not actively competing, they may be invited at the discretion of HLSR Management.*
 - ii. Three Special Invitations from HLSR Management.
 - iii. Reigning Canadian Professional Rodeo Association Champion.
 - iv. Reigning Xtreme Bulls Champion.
 - v. Top three from the published 2016 CBR World Standings.
 - vi. Top three from the published 2016 PBR World Standings.
 - vii. 2017 San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Champion.
 - viii. 2016 All American ProRodeo Finals Champion.
 - ix. Top two of the published 2017 official PRCA world standings (as of Dec. 1, 2016).
 - x. Top five of the published 2016 official ERA world standings.
 - xi. Remaining invitations will come from the published 2016 official PRCA world standings.

(c) Barrel Racing invitation criteria:

- i. Past four (4) RODEOHOUSTON Super Series Champions (2013 – 2016).
**Past RODEOHOUSTON Super Series Champions must be actively competing professionally, in the event they won, to be invited to compete. If not actively competing, they may be invited at the discretion of HLSR Management.*
- ii. Three Special Invitations from HLSR Management.
- iii. Reigning Canadian Professional Rodeo Association Champion.
- iv. 2017 San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Champion.
- v. 2016 All American ProRodeo Finals Champion.
- vi. Top two of the published 2017 official WPRA ProRodeo Standings (as of Dec. 1, 2016).
- vii. Top three of the published 2016 official WPRA Tour standings.
- viii. Remaining invitations will come from the published 2016 official WPRA ProRodeo Standings.

**Barrel Racers must be a WPRA member no later than noon on December 27, 2016 (CT), in order for their entry to be accepted and eligible to compete.*

(d) Team Roping invitation criteria for both Headers and Heelers:

- i. Past four (4) RODEOHOUSTON Super Series Champions (2013 – 2016).
**Past RODEOHOUSTON Super Series Champions must be actively competing professionally, in the event they won, to be invited to compete. If not actively competing, they may be invited at the discretion of HLSR Management.*
- ii. Three Special Invitations from HLSR Management.
- iii. Reigning Canadian Professional Rodeo Association Champion.
- iv. 2017 San Angelo Stock Show & Rodeo Champion.
- v. 2016 All American ProRodeo Finals Champion.
- vi. Top two of the published 2017 official PRCA world standings (as of Dec. 1, 2016).
- vii. Top five of the published 2016 official ERA world standings.
- ix. Remaining invitations will come from the published 2016 official PRCA world standings.

The 40 headers that are selected must rope with the 40 heelers that are selected to compete. If a contestant's partner is drawn out due to qualification, the contestant who qualified will not be allowed to draw out. A replacement partner will be drawn at random from the other contestants whose partners were drawn out due to qualification.

- (e) Alternate entries will be accepted. Entered alternates will be used to fill positions of invited contestants who did not complete the entry process or who elect not to compete, for whatever reason, to include medical release. HLSR management, at their sole discretion, will determine the rank order of entered alternates.

- (f) All contestants must be in good standing with HLSR.
