

## 2019 WPRA WORLD FINALS GROUND RULES CARD HOLDERS/PERMIT ONLY/JUNIORS/ ROPING/FUTURITY/DERBY

### I. Quick Tips:

Read the rules

- ✓ Keep a copy of your entry when you enter.
- ✓ If you want to stall together, one person must buy the stalls on one entry. No exceptions! If you have a special request (stallion stall, etc.), send an email to hannahk@wpra.com.
- ✓ Upon your arrival, you should visit the stall office to present your coggins/health papers (if applicable). You will also receive your stall assignment, RV assignment, contestant bag and back number. The stall office is open 24 hours during the event.
- ✓ It is not necessary to check-in with the Main Office located in the Coliseum. We encourage all contestants to visit the event board located outside of the Main Office to confirm their race positions and results. Draw numbers for your entry can also be found on [www.wpra.com](http://www.wpra.com) prior to the event.

### II. Entries:

- a. **Online** — Entries open August 21, 2019 and will close October 14, 2019 9:00pm MT. You may enter online at [www.wpra.com](http://www.wpra.com).
- b. **Fax** — Entries open August 21, 2019 and will close October 14, 2019 9:00pm MT. You may enter by filling out a fax entry form found at [www.wpra.com](http://www.wpra.com) on WPRA Finals page. Fax entry form to 866-644-1897.
- c. **Events to Enter:**
  - i. Card Only Race - \$250 Entry Fee. \$15,000 added
  - ii. Permit Only Race - \$250 Entry Fee. \$5,000 added
  - iii. Junior 4D - \$200 Entry Fee \$5,000 added
  - iv. Futurity - \$300 Entry Fee. \$10,000 added
  - v. Derby - \$300 Entry Fee. \$10,000 added
  - vi. Divisional Circuit Side Pot - \$60 Entry Fee. \$1,500 added
  - vii. Gold Card Side Pot - \$60 Entry Fee. \$1,500 added
  - viii. Roping - \$380 Entry Fee per event/person. \$5,000 added per event/side in Team Roping (Tie Down, Breakaway, and Team Roping)
  - ix. All Around Barrel Race - \$100 Entry Fee (must be entered in World Finals Roping)
  - x. RFD TV's The American Breakaway Side Pot off of World Finals Average — \$350 Refer to section XII.f.
  - xi. Troxel Helmet Incentive - \$25 entry fee, \$500 added – Off the All Girl 5D Saturday
- d. **Events to Enter Onsite:**
  - i. World Series Team Roping All Girl Qualifier — 4 for \$300 per team (2020)
  - ii. 2020 All Girl Kickoff Rodeo — \$100 Entry Fee per event/person \$500 added per event/side in Team Roping
  - iii. RFD TV's The American Breakaway Side Pot off of the 2020 All Girl Kickoff Rodeo — \$350 Refer to section XII.f.
  - iv. Sunday All Around Event - \$80 per event/person \$100 added per event/side in Team Roping. (All Around Barrels run with Sunday All Girl 5D - \$20 late fee if entering on site.)
  - v. RFD TV's The American Breakaway Side Pot off of the Sunday All Around Event — \$350 Refer to section XII.f.
  - vi. All girl 5D Jackpots – \$60 See Separate ground rules

### III. Drawing Out:

- a. Draw-out deadline is 5:00pm Wednesday October 23, 2019.
  - b. The draw-out Form must be returned by FAX or EMAIL by the deadline to receive a draw-out refund.
  - c. The draw-out form is for entry fees, stall fees, and RV fees, less a 25% draw out charge regardless of when draw out was submitted/processed.
  - d. No Doctor or Vet release paperwork is needed.
  - e. After the deadline, no refunds will be given for any reason.

### IV. Stalls and RVs

- a. Barn will open for check-in Wednesday October 23, 2019 at 12:00pm (noon).
- b. You may check into your reserved stalls and/or RV spaces on the date reserved. Shavings must be purchased in the stall office. No outside shavings allowed. No portable panels or tying horses to trailers overnight is allowed.
- c. All stalls will be pre-assigned. If you are traveling in a group and would like for the horses in your group to be stalled near each other, one of the members in your group must reserve all needed stalls to guarantee your stalls will be together.
- d. **YOU MUST STALL AT NIGHT** — after 11:30 PM, horses must be stalled at the Extraco Event Center or taken off location. Tie-outs or the use of portable fences (electric or panel) is strictly prohibited anywhere on the facility. If caught violating, you will be fined \$100 per occurrence and cannot compete until the fine is paid.

- e. Stall Pricing
  - i. Wednesday , October 23 — \$20 Stall Charge
  - ii. Thursday — Saturday, October 24 - 26: \$110 Stall Charge
  - iii. Friday — Saturday, October 25 - 26: \$90 Stall Charge
- f. RV Pricing
  - i. Wednesday, October 23 — \$25 RV Charge
  - ii. Thursday — Saturday, October 24 - 26: \$125 RV Charge
  - iii. Friday — Saturday, October 25 -26: \$100 RV Charge

### V. Health Certificates & Coggins

- a. Coggins: Both in and out of state must have a current coggins test.
- b. Health Certificate: All out of state horses are required to have a current health certificate. In state horses must comply with any Texas requirements.

### VI. Contestant Requirements

- a. Contestants are responsible for having knowledge of applicable WPRA rules, and procedures in events entered. These Ground Rules supersede any other rule contained in WPRA RULEBOOK.
- b. All members entering WPRA classes must be financially eligible at the time entries close or they will be drawn out.
- c. All bills associated with the WPRA World Finals must be settled with the WPRA Accountant (who will be at the Finals) before you leave the Extraco Event Center. Failure to settle your bills will result in a \$50 service charge.
- d. When you are called you must be ready. There are 3 calls within 60 seconds after which you will be disqualified.
- e. All WPRA members must wear WPRA patch for all World Finals event go-rounds while in the competition arena and during official award photos.
- i. Patches will be distributed at contestant check-in. Failure to wear WPRA patch will constitute a \$100 fine per occurrence.
- f. All contestants must have a back number and it must be worn while competing.
- g. Dress code is required while in the holding pen.
- h. The WPRA may at its discretion may video any and all competition runs. They are for WPRA purposes only and do not replace the judge's decision.
- i. Horse abuse on the event grounds will not be tolerated.
- j. If a contestant is scheduled to compete in both the Coliseum Arena and the Show Pavilion Arena in separate competitions at the same time, the Coliseum Arena will take priority. It is entirely the responsibility of those contestants in possible conflict to bring the situation to the Roping Arena Secretary beforehand so arrangements can be made.

### VII. Drawing Out

Note: Your membership status (Card, Permit, Active Gold Card, and Junior) at the time of your entry determines which barrel event you may enter.

#### a. Card Only Race — \$250 Entry Fee. \$15,000 added

- i. 2019 & 2020 WPRA Card Holders
- ii. 2 long rounds + finals. Top 30 aggregate (total on 2) times from the 2 long rounds will be taken back to the finals round. The fastest 3 run aggregate (total on 3) determines the 2019 WPRA World Finals Champion.
- iii. Top 2 ladies in the World Finals Average will qualify for 2020 RodeoHouston.
- iv. 100% of the added money and 75% of the entry fees going into the purse.

#### b. Permit Only Race — \$250 Entry Fee. \$5,000 added

- i. 2019 & 2020 WPRA Permit Holders
- ii. 2 long rounds + finals. Top 30 aggregate (total on 2) times from the 2 long rounds will be taken back to the finals round. The fastest 3 run aggregate (total on 3) determines the 2019 WPRA World Finals Champion.
- iii. 100% of the added money and 75% of entry fees going into the purse.
- iv. The purse is split — 30% to each long round, 10% to the finals round and 30% to the aggregate (total on 3).
- v. Long rounds will pay on a 2D format with a .5 second split between the "D"s. 70% going to the 1D and 30% to the 2D.

#### c. Junior 4D — \$200 Entry Fee \$5,000 added

- i. 2019 & 2020 WPRA Junior Members
- ii. 2 long rounds only. The fastest 2 run aggregate (total on 2) determines the 2019 Junior World Finals Champion.
- iii. **Winners of each division in each go round will earn a wild card qualification into the 2020 NBHA Youth World Championships (Must be a NBHA member to qualify)**
- iv. Contestants may enter multiple horses. In no case will the same horse be run more than once in the same class. All horses must be named at time of entry. Riders with multiple entries must ride their horses in the position in which they draw. Only the highest placing will count.
- v. 100% of the added money and 75% of entry fees going into the purse.
- vi. 4D 1/2 second between each D
- vii. 50/50 per round (NO AVERAGE) Follow NBHA guideline for a 4 D—35%(1D)/30%(2D)/20%(3D)/15%(4D)

#### d. Futurity — \$300 Entry Fee. \$10,000 added

- i. 2019 & 2020 WPRA Card, Permit, Active Gold Card, and Junior members. Horses must be nominated on or prior to October 5th
- ii. 2 long rounds only. The fastest 2 run aggregate (total on 2) determines the 2019 WPRA World Finals Champions.
- iii. Includes 1 exhibition reserved at check in
- iv. Will pay out for 2 long rounds and an aggregate (total on 2).
- v. Long rounds will pay on the 2D format with a 1 second split between "D"s, with 70% going to the 1D and 30% to the 2D. The aggregate (total on 2) will be paid out in the 1D and 2D.
- vi. Purse split is 30% to each round and 40% to the aggregate (total on 2).

### e. Derby — \$300 Entry Fee. \$10,000 added

- i. 2019 & 2020 WPRA Card, Permit, Active Gold Card, and Junior members. Horses must be nominated on or prior to October 5th.
- ii. 2 long rounds only. The fastest 2 run aggregate (total on 2) determines the 2019 WPRA World Finals Champions.
- iii. Includes 1 exhibition reserved at check in
- iv. Will pay out for 2 long rounds and an aggregate (total on 2).
- v. 1D format in both long rounds and the aggregate (total on 2), with 100% of the added money and 75% of the entry fees going to the purse.
- vi. Purse split is 30% to each round and 40% to the aggregate (total on 2).

**Futurity/Derby Horse Check In** — Thursday, October 24, 2019 between 1:00-3:00 PM across from the warm-up area. Copy of registration papers must accompany each horse.

- Failure to check in between 1:00-3:00PM will result in \$100 fine per horse.
- Late check in for Futurity & Derby: Thursday, October 24, 2019 between 6:00-6:30. Exhibitions will not be assigned at late check in (\$100 fine per horse).
- There will be no check in's allowed outside of the scheduled check in times. Horses not checked in will be disqualified.

### f. Divisional Circuit Side Pot — \$60 Entry Fee. \$1,500 added

- i. 2019 & 2020 WPRA Card holders and Permit holders
- ii. Side pot off of the WPRA Card Only, Permit Only and Junior first rounds, and will count towards 2020 applicable standings.
- iii. Only one horse may be entered in this side pot.
- iv. 100% of the added money and 75% of the entry fees going into the purse.

### g. Gold Card Side Pot — \$60 Entry Fee. \$1,500 added

- i. 2019 & 2020 WPRA Active Gold Card holders
- ii. Side pot off of the WPRA Card Only race second round or the Saturday All Girl 5D Barrel Race Jackpot.
- iii. You must have a current 2019 or 2020 WPRA Active Gold Card to be eligible.
- iv. Only one horse may be entered in this side pot.
- v. Does not count toward Divisional Circuit Standings
- vi. 100% of the added money and 75% of the entry fees going into the purse.

### h. 2020 All Girl Kickoff Rodeo — \$100 Entry Fee per event/person \$500 added per event

- i. Thursday, October 24, 2019, 7:00 pm
- ii. Enter on site. Female non-members accepted.
- iii. Barrel race will be run in coliseum arena
- iv. 100% of the added money and 75% of entry fees going into the purse.
- v. Barrel payoff Up to \$1000: 4 places \$1000.01-\$2000.00: 6 places \$2000.01-\$4000.00: 8 places \$4000.01-\$9999.99: 10 places \$10,000 to \$15,000.00: 12 places \$15,000.01 and up: 15 places.
- i. Breakaway Roping and Calf Roping payoff up to \$1,200: 4 places \$1,200.01-\$3,500: 6 places \$3,500.01 and over: 8 places. Payoff for Team Roping (per team, not per woman) up to \$2,400: 4 places \$2,400.01-\$7,000: 6 places \$7,000.01 and over: 8 places.

### i. Troxel Helmet Incentive — \$25 Entry Fee. \$500 added

- i. Off of the Saturday All Girl 5D Barrel Race Jackpot
- ii. Enter on site. Female non-members accepted.
- iii. 100% of the added money and 80% of entry fees going into purse.
- iv. 4D scale equal payout

## VIII. Horse/ Rider Changes

- a. Futurity/Derby: Horse and rider changes will be accepted through futurity/derby check in.
  - i. \$15 charge for each horse change
  - ii. \$25 for each rider change.
- b. All other World Finals Classes: Horse changes will be accepted no later than 2 hours prior to the start of the World Finals Class.
  - i. There is a \$15 charge for every horse change.
  - ii. No Rider changes accepted.
- c. All Girl 5D – Horse changes will be accepted up to the below deadlines:
  - i. Race 1 Friday at 5:30 PM
  - ii. Race 2 on Saturday at 7:15 AM
  - iii. Race 3 on Sunday at 10:00 AM
  - iv. \$15 charge for every horse change.
  - v. No rider changes accepted.

## IX. WPRA Barrel Race Awards (Cards, Permits, Junior, Futurity & Derby)

- a. All WPRA Barrel Race awards are presented on Sunday, October 27, 2019 in the Back Porch Club at the conclusion of the events.
- b. Dress code is required for all presentations.
- c. If the Year End World Champion or World Finals Average Champion is not present at the World Finals, on Sunday, awards will be shipped to her (at her own expense) or provided to someone that she has designated to receive them for her.
- d. All Year End & World Finals Average award recipients (Reserve Champion – 5th) must be present to receive awards. If not present at the time of presentation, the awards will be forfeited, or provided to someone that she has designated to receive them for her. There are no exceptions.

### e. Futurity/Derby

Year End –

- i. Year End World Champion is determined by taking the 2019 Year End Standings coming into the World Finals and adding any money/points won in the applicable class, which includes the final classes on Sunday, October 27, 2019.
- ii. Top Five in the final World Standings for Futurity 1D, 2D and Derby are awarded.

World Finals Average –

- i. Top Five in the World Finals Average and Go-Round Winners in Futurity 1D and Derby will be awarded.

### f. Junior

Year End –

- i. Year End World Champion is determined by taking the 2019 Year End Standings coming into the World Finals and adding any money/points won in the applicable class, which includes the final classes on Sunday, October 27, 2019.
- ii. Top Five in the final Year End World Standings will be awarded.

World Finals Average –

- i. Top Five in the World Finals Average and each Go-Round Winner will be awarded.

### g. Cards

World Finals Average –

- i. Top Five in the World Finals Average and each Go-Round Winner will be awarded.

### h. Permits

World Finals Average –

- i. Top Five in the World Finals Average and each Go-Round Winner will be awarded.

## X. BARREL RACING REQUIREMENTS

- a. Barrel Racing times must be read and recorded by official timer in 1000ths of a second.
- b. Drag after every 5 runs and big drag at every 50 runs.
- c. There will be one judge for the barrel race.
- d. Equine Medication testing can or will take place on event grounds.

## XI. Filling Your Permit at the 2019 World Finals

- a. Money won in the 1D in the Permit Only race, All Girl 5D Barrel Race Jackpot and the 2020 Kickoff All Girl Rodeo count towards filling your permit.
- b. If you fill your permit while at the 2019 World Finals, you may continue to compete BUT any money won in excess over the \$1,000 permit limit does not count toward your WPRA Card.

## XII. Roping Event Information and Eligibility

### a. Roping — \$380 Entry Fee per event/person. \$5,000 added per event/side in Team Roping

- i. Tie Down, Breakaway, and Team Roping
- ii. 4 long rounds. The fastest 4 run aggregate (total on 4) determines the 2019 WPRA World Finals Champions.
- iii. The payoff amount is 100% of the added money and 75% of entry fees going into the purse.
- iv. Rule 6.4.4 Four Go Rounds and average\* is two times the go round. Divide the aforementioned total by 6 and the answer will be the go round. Twice the answer will be the average\* money.
- v. Rule 6.4.1 Average\* will pay same number of places as the go-rounds. Up to \$1200 — 4 monies  
\$1200.01-\$3500 — 6 monies  
\$3500.01 and over — 8 monies

### b. All Around Barrel Race — \$100 Entry Fee(must be entered in World Finals Roping)

- i. 1 run in the Roping Arena.
- ii. Counts towards the 2019 All Around Standings
- iii. The 2019 All Around Barrel Race points will be based on 5000 points (corresponding with Roping \$5,000.00 added) and 285 points per entry (corresponding with Roping adjusted entry fee)
- iv. 75% of the entry fees go into the purse.
- v. All Around Barrels Payoff Up to \$1000: 4 places  
\$1000.01-\$2000.00: 6 places  
\$2000.01-\$4000.00: 8 places  
\$4000.01-\$9999.99: 10 places  
\$10,000 to \$15,000.00: 12 places  
\$15,000.01 and up: 15 places.
- vi. Points in the 2019 All Around Barrel Race will be awarded towards the 2019 All Around Standings and will be calculated as if there were equal added money and equal entry fee as in the other roping events. The 2019 All Around Barrel Race points will be based on 5000 points (corresponding with Roping \$5,000.00 added) and 285 points per entry (corresponding with Roping adjusted entry fee)
- vii. Per the payoff scales, a minimum of 10 places of All Round points will be awarded.

- c. World Series Team Roping All Girl Qualifier** — 4 for \$300 per team
- Thursday, October 24, 2019 9:00am
  - Enter twice TRIAD #11, must be 21 years of age, USTRC or World Series Membership required. Winning team qualifies for 2020 World Series Finale, Las Vegas, NV.
- d. 2020 All Girl Kickoff Rodeo** — \$100 Entry Fee per event/person \$500 added per event/side in Team Roping
- Thursday, October 24, 2019, 7:00 pm
  - Enter on site. Female non-members accepted. Team Roping may enter twice. 75% pay back on entry fees and 100% of the added money in all events. Earnings from the 2020 All Girl Kickoff Rodeo events will count for the 2020 competition year. All Around points are calculated when contestant places in more than one event in WPRA Sanctioned/Co-approved All Women's Timed Event Rodeo/Jackpots that have all four ladies events. Breakaway is co-approved with Rafter L. and UPRA. Co-approved with Prairie Circuit.
  - Barrel race will be run in coliseum arena
  - 100% of the added money and 75% of entry fees going into the purse.
  - iBarrel payoff Up to \$1000: 4 places \$1000.01-\$2000.00: 6 places \$2000.01-\$4000.00: 8 places \$4000.01-\$9999.99: 10 places \$10,000 to \$15,000.00: 12 places \$15,000.01 and up: 15 places.
  - Breakaway Roping and Calf Roping payoff up to \$1,200: 4 places \$1,200.01-\$3,500: 6 places \$3,500.01 and over: 8 places. Payoff for Team Roping (per team, not per woman) up to \$2,400: 4 places \$2,400.01-\$7,000: 6 places \$7,000.01 and over: 8 places.
- e. Sunday All Around Event** — \$80 per event/person \$100 added per event/side in Team Roping
- Co-approved with Prairie Circuit. All Around Barrel Racing Must be entered in a WPRA Sunday roping event and be entered in the 5D All Girl Barrels in the Barrel Arena.
  - Tie Down, Breakaway, and Team Roping Co-approved with Prairie Circuit and All Around Barrel Racing Side pot.
- f. RFD TV's The American Breakaway Side Pots** — \$350 Entry Fee each
- i. 3 Separate Qualifiers as side pots off of the following:**
- Thursday, October 24 — All Girl Kickoff Rodeo (Enter Onsite)
  - Friday, October 25 Through Saturday, October 26 — World Finals Average (Pre entry with World Finals Classes – No onsite entries)
  - Sunday, October 27 — All Around Event (Enter Onsite)
- 25% payback in side pot, remaining 75% to the Semi-finals and the American Rodeo.
  - Payout and semi-finalist:
    - Thursday Kickoff Rodeo Side Pot — 1 head.
    - World Finals Average Side Pot will be determined from the 4 head average only and jackpot side pot will pay on average only.
    - Sunday All Around Event Side Pot — 1 head.
  - Money won in side pots will count for 2020 WPRA Breakaway Standings.
  - Number of Qualifiers for the Semi-finals in Fort Worth will be dependent on the number of entries.

### XIII. Roping Contestant Requirements/Awards

- There is a MANDATORY Roping Contestant Meeting and Awards Reception on Thursday, October 24, 2019, from 2:00-4:30pm in the Back Porch Club top level in the Coliseum. This meeting and reception are important. If you do not attend there will be a \$50 fine. All contestants should have your head shot taken by the photographer before the reception. Dress code required. You will be responsible for knowing and complying with instructions/ information presented at the Contestant Meeting and Awards Reception. Awards will be presented to Top 15 roping contestants based on the Point Cutoff on September 3, 2019, who are entered in the World Finals and Roping Circuit Awards will be given at this reception with the exception of circuits with a roping finals.
- Contestants must be present after the 4th round on Saturday, October 26, 2019 at 5:30pm to receive awards in the Back Porch room.

- c. World Finals Average Top Five, final World Standings Top Five entered in World Finals, Go-Round Winners and Rookie Awards will be presented. If not present, non-championship awards are forfeited. Dress code required. A coin toss will break any ties for awards.
- d. World Titles, WPRA All Around Cowgirl Title and Rookie Titles will be awarded to the 2019 contestant who has won the most money in their category throughout the year and at the Finals event combined. At the conclusion of the World Finals, if Title leaders were not entered and are not present, title will remain and Championship awards will be shipped at Title winner's expense or a form must be completed to have items released.
- e. Circuit Titles will be named based on the contestant in each circuit who has won the most money by the point cut-off date in their respective event. Circuit winners are not required to enter the World Finals to receive their circuit awards. Point Cut-off date is September 3, 2019. (Unless a Breakaway Circuit Finals is held.)
- f. The WPRA World Finals will be the LAST STOP for the Breakaway Wrangle Network Tour. Points will be awarded in each of the 4 go-rounds as well as the World Finals average.

### XIV. ROPING RULES/REQUIREMENTS

- a. Equine Medication testing can or will take place on event grounds.
- b. Contestants will be allowed one (1) cattle pusher, and one (1) assistant in roping box (If needed). Contestant is responsible for the behavior and appearance of their pusher and/or assistant. All pushers/assistants must be in WPRA dress code at all times while in arena and in chute. Pusher and assistant must be in chute and/or box when contestant is called.
- c. When you are called you must be ready. There are 3 calls made within 60 seconds after which you will be turned out and/or fined \$100 for that round. Pushers and assistants must leave the arena immediately after contestant performs. Pusher/assistant is bound by all WPRA rules of conduct and must follow instructions from arena director.
- d. Contestants will be allowed in the arena at specified times. Circling before and between events is prohibited with a \$100 fine. A warm up arena will be provided.
- e. Tie Down Roping If roper fails to get calf up per rule 12.2.3, a 10 second penalty will be assessed. Judge will signal timer of the penalty.
- f. Breakaway contestants will be required to use colored string provided by Breakaway Director.
- g. Team ropers will not be allowed to switch ends with the same partner.
- h. Cattle extras will be designated rather than part of whole herd.
- i. If you miss a round of competition, you will get a no time but still qualify for the aggregate (total on 4).
- j. There will be WPRA co-approved roping jackpots on Sunday morning in the Pavilion Roping arena. Sunday entries will be taken in the Pavilion Roping arena. (Barrel Racers must enter the 2019 5D All Girl Barrel Race in the Coliseum Arena. Pre enter to avoid late fee and late draw number)
- k. One loop will be allowed in the tie down roping and the breakaway roping and two loops allowed in the team roping.
- l. If a contestant is scheduled to compete in both the Coliseum Arena and the Show Pavilion Arena in separate competitions at the same time, the Coliseum Arena will take priority. It is entirely the responsibility of those contestants in possible conflict to bring the situation to the Roping Arena Secretary beforehand so arrangements can be made.

# 2019 WPRA WORLD FINALS GROUND RULES

## CARD HOLDERS/PERMIT ONLY/JUNIORS/ ROPING/FUTURITY/DERBY

- v. **Round Four** — Saturday, October 26, 2019 1 hour after the completion of Round Three. Round Four will be slowest to fastest in the aggregate (total on 4) based on the first three rounds.
- vi. Contestants should notify secretary of contestants riding the same horses at least 30 minutes before the rodeo to split runs.
- vii. Contestants with conflicts in the Coliseum Barrel arena should immediately notify WPRA World Finals Office/Roping Director. Cattle may be held back per arena directors specifications.

### XVI. Carry Over Times

- a. Card Holder Race is eligible to carry over to the following.
  - i. Futurity (If you don't make the short round in the card holders race, you will run in the 2nd go of the Futurity on Sunday at the bottom random draw) (If you make the short round in the card holders race you will run in the short round and your time will carry back to the Futurity 2nd round.)
  - ii. Derby (If you make the short round in the card holders race you will run in the short round and your time will carry back to the Derby 2nd round.) (If you don't make the short round in the card holders race, you will run in the 2nd go around of Derby, on Sunday at the bottom random draw)
  - iii. All Girl 5D Barrel Race Jackpots (Friday, Saturday and Sunday.) (If you don't make the short round you will be added to the late entry draw for Sunday.)
  - iv. Gold Card Side pot (If you are an active WPRA Gold Card Holder.)
  - v. Divisional Circuit side pot.
