WPRA President J. Munroe calls the meeting to order.

Topic #1: Member Major Rule Violation Hearing: Continuation of a member hearing started on 8/16/23. This portion of the hearing has additional evidence from the party submitting the violation. Alleged violation rules are: 9.3.3, 9.3.6, 9.3.7, and 9.3.14. Relates to member or member's family who, recklessly, knowingly or willfully causes trouble.....excessive complaining, causing disturbances...., attempting to.....harass judge or other officials, ...making detrimental statements.....involved in an act.....inconsistent with the best interests of the WPRA...

Hearing and deliberation.

Motion by: I move that the Board find the member in violation of major rules 9.3.3 and 9.3.14 with a fine of \$1500. The member is not in violation of rules 9.3.6 and 9.3.7.

- There is a question if the WPRA will be supplying WPRA patches and if yes will fines for noncompliance be the same as the PRCA. P.2 in ground rules.
- There is a procedural question about ties. P. 1 in ground rules.
